## 107. MATTERS REFERRED FROM PARISH COUNCIL

### a) Holme Meadow Drainage

The Clerk reported that the NLC Community Grant is no longer available in this financial year. It was agreed that the situation has become urgent so it was agreed to contract Mr Branston to carry out the additional drainage work as soon as possible and to pay for it from the cash flow. It was agreed that the rodding of the drains should be shelved until next year but to ask the handyman to clear approx. 18 yards in the bottom of the dyke.

# b) Adult Outdoor Fitness Equipment

The Clerk provided a range of leaflets of available equipment for information. After discussion it was agreed that the placing of adult equipment in the children's play area would not be appropriate due to the opening hours. It was also agreed that a separate area would need some form of security to protect the equipment as all suitable areas in the village, i.e. playing field, Holme Meadow or village hall, are not in constant public view and therefore vulnerable to abuse. Agreed to take no further action at this time.

- b) LITTER BINS Cllr. Sherwood reported that the bins are constantly full to overflowing. It was agreed to ask Neighbourhood Services for details of the emptying schedule.
