# d) Applications for Grant Aid (\$137)

- 2. Messingham Memorial Playing Field £4968 requested for the repair of the access road. It was noted that this is an ongoing issue but that the playing field committee has offered to forego making a precept grant application if approved. It was agreed to make provision in the budget but the work to be approved when all enquiries are completed. **Budget £5000.**
- 3. Messingham Methodist Chapel £1500 requested for renewal of gutters and down pipes. Granted **£1500**
- 4. Messingham Junior Cricket Club £600 requested for portable cricket practice net. Granted £600
- Messingham Beaver Scouts £150 requested for melamine mugs. Granted £150
- 6. Messingham Guides £300 requested towards hire of minibus for weekend camp. Granted £300
- 7. HWRCC Community Transport Donation towards running costs of the community transport service. Granted £100
